Notes:

- 1. The nonmember subscription fees drop by \$30K due to freezing the rate at the current level of \$1025 rather than increasing it 12% to \$1150, as recommended by IEEE Marketing.
- 2. Transactions expense increases by \$45K due to increasing the page budget from 5300 to 5700.
- 3. Conference income and expense are based on a 10% surplus for ISIT 2009 (income \$387K, expense \$347K) and the approved budget for the 2009 ITW in Volos, Greece (income \$48K, expense \$42K). The Taormina workshop will be added to the budget when approved.
- 4. Committee expenses are increased by \$116K to include \$30K for the Awards Luncheon (previously unbudgeted), \$15K for the Student Committee, \$20K for School support, \$3K for the Women in IT initiative, and an increase in the IT Web budget from \$12K to \$60K.
- 5. Newsletter budget is increased to \$35K to allow increased pages.
